### Creative Arts Activities

#### Arts & Crafts

Fun, creative, cool crafts for all to enjoy

#### Cartooning

Don't just read the comics, create them! From caricatures to creating your own comic book, this class is a fun way to express your creativity.

#### Ceramics

Hand building, sculpting and constructing, focusing on basic techniques and decorating with glazes

#### Leather Crafts

Use stitching, hammers and stamping tools to design key chains, wristbands and bookmarks from various leathers and suedes.

Work with copper, aluminum, tin and other metals to create GREAT projects. Check out our awesome 3D crafts that we create with metals and more.

#### Mosaic Art

Learn how to work with tile and grout to make cool tile creations — picture frames, trivets, tile paintings and other unique creations.

#### Painting

Go crazy with color as we explore acrylic, pastels and watercolors on canvas, tiles, masks and more.

#### Things That Go

Make boats, kites, planes and rockets - anything that goes.

#### Wearable Art

We'll make bandanas, hemp bracelets and other cool projects. Everything you make here is WEARABLE.

Fun for campers who enjoy ceramics and want a new experience using a potter's wheel.

Using hammers, paint, stain and glue, you'll build cool projects from scratch. Birdhouses, toolboxes, stools, games and more!

## Performing Arts Activities

### Musical Theater

2 productions per season: **one during week 4 and one during week 7**. Each production will be presented on stage at the Katz JCC. Theater requires rehearsal time for both shows at the Katz JCC. *You must sign up every time that theater is offered, which is 5 times per week. You are guaranteed to get theater, so you do NOT need to pick alternative activity choices during the theater periods.*

### Acting Workshop

Campers will learn stage presence skills to help them become great actors and actresses. *You do not need to be part of the theater program to sign up for this activity.*

### Hip Hop Dance

Have fun listening to your favorite music while you learn the latest hip hop moves. *You do not need to be part of the theater program to sign up for this activity.*

### Improvisation

Whose line is it anyway? Yours! Learn how to use different objects and character voices to make friends and family laugh. Don't miss out on this hilarious class. *You do not need to be part of the theater program to sign up for this activity.*

### Jam'Nastics

This activity combines gymnastics with the latest dance moves. Don't miss out on tumbling and jammin' to your favorite music. *You do not need to be part of the theater program to sign up for this activity.*

### Performing Dance

This class is for campers who want to show off their newly acquired skills in dance. Campers will rehearse for 2 dance recitals performed on the Katz JCC stage prior to the Camp Aaron shows. You must sign up every time that performing dance is offered (3 times a week — Mon., Tues. & Thurs.). *You do not need to be part of the theater program to sign up for this activity.*

### Set Production

Campers will learn background design and help build and paint sets for the camp shows. This will also be an opportunity to learn other behind the scene aspects of the shows. *You do not need to be part of the theater program to sign up for this activity.*

### Singing

Learn the latest vocal exercises to sing like your favorite stars. *You do not need to be part of the theater program to sign up for this activity.*

## Sports and Recreation Activities

All sports will include some instructional time as well as playing the "game." All sports offerings are open to both boys and girls, unless otherwise indicated on the activity selection sheet. Camp supplies all necessary sporting equipment unless otherwise listed. **Campers MUST wear sneakers or they will not be able to participate.**

- Archery** Ready, aim, fire! Work on your skills and see how many bulls-eyes you can get.
- Basketball** Practice your free throw, lay up and jump shot. We play fast paced, friendly games.
- Competitive Sports** Organized teams, high-spirited games like softball, baseball, soccer and hockey. You must sign up every time that competitive sports is offered, which is 2 times per week.
- Football** 24, 68, Hike! Go out for a long pass with your friends during a fun-filled game of flag football.
- Ga Ga** One of the most popular games at camp - it is similar to dodge ball but it is played in a rink. *When selecting Ga Ga, please write the court name as it is listed on the selection sheet.*
- Golf Chipping Range** Learn the short game of golf at our chipping range! We'll work on the proper technique of your swing. Using irons (not drivers) you'll learn to focus and hit targets at various distances.
- Hockey** Take a shot, score a goal, and make a save on our awesome covered hockey rink. Please send your camper with a mouth guard to participate in this activity.
- Kickball** What can we say? Kick the ball, catch the ball, and run fast.
- Lacrosse** Make a pass, take a shot, or score a goal playing this exciting sport.
- Mini-Golf** FORE! Tee up at our 9-hole professional course, learn how to keep score and challenge your friends.
- Newcombe** This popular game is just like volleyball but you catch the ball instead of hitting it right back. Let's see you catch, throw and dive on our sand court.
- Soccer** We play traditional soccer and some really cool variations of this popular game.
- Softball** Pitch, hit, catch and run on our awesome Camp Aaron baseball diamond.
- Volleyball** Work on your bump, set and spike on our sand volleyball court.
- Tennis** Serve up some fun with your friends as you play doubles and singles and work on your forehand, backhand and serve.
- Tennis Baseball** Swing and run as we "serve" up a twisted version of typical baseball.
- Yoga** Exercise, relax, and increase your flexibility. This class will give you a balanced mind and body and great posture. What a great way to start the camp day!

## General Interest Activities

- Boating** Campers may boat, kayak or paddleboat on our 4 acre lake.
- Cheerleading** Learn new skills as a cheerleader – you’ll work on basic tumbling skills, formations and learn new cheers
- Climbing Boulder** Traverse a 15 foot climbing boulder and challenge yourself to follow a our preset courses
- Digital Photography** Create memories of camp using digital cameras. Enhance and edit your images. Create personalized mouse pads, t-shirts, bags and more. Digital camera is provided by camp.
- Fishing** Reel in a big catch at our fishing dock (rods & bait are provided by camp)
- Games** Capture the Flag? Backyard Games? Water Balloon Tosses? All the FUN Camp games.
- Guitar Club** This class covers the basics of the instrument, covering chords, soloing and basic songs. You must take this course 2 times per week (the classes are linked and noted with arrows across 2 days) so you can really learn the basics.
- Advanced Guitar** Refine your guitar skills and stage presence. **Pre-Requisite:** Must have participated in a prior guitar class at camp or lessons at home/school.
- Kosher Cooking** Learn how to make great snacks, easy meals and delicious desserts.
- Lake Inflatables** You'll go crazy when you see our trampoline, inflatable slides and climbing structures in the middle of the lake!
- Nature & Outdoor Adventure** Encounter the great outdoors – you’ll experience nature in the best setting – the pinelands! Our 120 acre campsite has many paths to explore and lots of materials to make unique creations.
- Newspaper** Are you an aspiring journalist, or just looking for a fun, new activity? Learn to write different types of articles for a published Camp Aaron paper.
- High Ropes Course** Climb our 20 foot Rock Wall, woosh down the Zip Line, challenge yourself on our high ropes elements such as the “Islands in the Sky” or the “Leap of Faith”. There are many NEW high ropes elements to challenge yourself on this summer.
- Low Ropes Course** Together you and your fellow campers will conquer our obstacle courses, find your way across a life-size spider web or challenge yourselves on our many new low elements. Teamwork is the answer as you find the fun in every challenge.
